- 'ĀLA'APAPA - an ancient, dramatic style of hula
- 'AMI - a hula step
- 'AUANA - the modern style of hula, to wander astray
- HĀLAU - a school of hula

- HAPA HAOLE - a style of music and hula mixing English and Hawaiian
- HELA - a hula step
- HI'IAKA - a goddess of hula, Pele's favorite sister
- HO'OPA'A - the second rank of graduated hula student, the drummer and chanter
- HULA KI'I - a style of hula
- 'ILI'ILI - small, smooth stones used by dancers
- IPU - a drum made of a single gourd or two gourds joined
- KĀ LA'AU - a hula implement of two sticks struck together
- KAHIKO - the traditional style of hula
- KĀHOLO - a hula step
- KĀ'EKE'EKE - bamboo pipes that create varied tones
- KA'O - a hula step
- KEPAKEPA - a style of chant that is fast and rhythmic
- KI'ELEI - a style of hula
- KŌLANI - a style of hula to honor a chief
- KU'I - a style of hula from Moloka'i with stomping
- KUMU - the third and final rank of graduated hula student, the teacher
- LAKA - a goddess of hula, maile, and other forest plants
- LELE - a hula step
- 'ŌLAPA - the first rank of graduated hula student, the dancer
- 'ŌNIU - a hula step
- PAHU - a hula drum
- PA'I UMAUMA - a chest slapping hula style
- PA'Ū HULA - dancing skirt
- PAPA HEHI - a footboard hula implement
- PELE - the goddess of volcanoes, many hula in honor of her
- PŪ'ILI - a bamboo rattle hula implement
- PŪNIU - a small knee drum made from half a coconut shell
- 'ULI'ULI - a hula implement rattle decorated with feathers
- 'ŪLILI - a hula step
- 'UWEHE - a hula step
